Mission, Vision, Strategy and Values of Bridge Fellowship Church Raleigh

Our vision is to reach the unchurched and disciple believers into a joy-filled relationship with Jesus. Specifically, ministry effectiveness looks like reaching 1% of South Raleigh with the gospel and connecting them into Bridge Fellowship Church.

Our strategy is to seek, connect, and grow. We will relentlessly Seek opportunities to share the Gospel and invite people to BFC. As they come, we will work to Connect them into the life of our church. Active growth happens as new worshippers Connect, get equipped, and relentlessly seek opportunities to share the Gospel and invite people to BFC.

About This Role

The role of the Worship Leader is to develop a music worship ministry that exalts Jesus Christ and focuses the congregation on Him. The Worship Leader is to lead and grow the music worship ministry at Bridge Fellowship Church.

Primary Responsibilities and Tasks of the Worship Leader

1. Plan, schedule, coordinate, and lead the music for Sunday Gatherings.
2. Create a high caliber worship ministry through the recruitment and development of instrumentalists and vocalists.
3. Create Job descriptions for the entire worship team utilizing BFC's template.
4. Meet bi-monthly with the Lead Pastor to: connect spiritually, review past services and plan for future services.
5. Discover and introduce new songs and prepare chord charts for each.
6. Assist in planning and/or leading worship for special events outside of weekend services.
7. Direct the weekly planning activities and rehearsals necessary to accomplish worship in weekend services.
8. Ensure proper stewardship of the worship ministry volunteers, budget, equipment and other resources.
9. Set annual goals for the worship ministry that align with the overall mission, vision, and goals of Bridge Fellowship Church.
10. Maintain the music library, instruments, and license agreements.

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Strengths & Skillset

1. Testimony of faith in Jesus Christ and a growing personal relationship with Him.
2. Commitment to the mission and vision of Bridge Fellowship, moral purity, and excellence in ministry.
3. A passion for worship and a humble, team-oriented heart.
4. Skilled instrumentalist and quality vocalist.
5. Knowledgeable in sound, lighting, and audio recording.
6. Proficient with ProPresenter, Planning Center Online, and Mac applications.

Your Team

This position reports to the Lead Pastor and works closely with the Production Coordinator and a team of worship ministry volunteers.

Key Performance Indicators

The strategy of the Worship Ministry that the Worship Leader is responsible for reflects the overall growth strategy of the church:

1. Evangelize and invite people to the Bridge
2. Connect people into church life and develop leaders
3. Serve, engage, and invite our community

The Worship Leader will be evaluated on the following three metrics:

1. Grow number of musicians/vocalists from 1 to 5
 - Identify, recruit, and train 3 new band members.
 - Schedule new band members for Sunday Worship.
2. Implement quarterly Worship Team Gatherings.
 - Organize two trainings
 - Organize two fun outings (this should include spouses)
3. Completed Worship calendar/playlist through 2023.
 - Collaborate with Lead Pastor to strategize and plan worship calendar for next ministry year.
 - Create arrangements and chords charts for each song.
 - Create/upload all slides needed for Sunday prior to Sunday (8AM)
 - Set day of the week for the band to receive setlist and music.

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Personal Responsibilities

While not specifically related to the job, here are some personal responsibilities of everyone in leadership at BFC.

- Maintain God-ordained priorities in your life by putting Jesus Christ first, your spouse second, your children third, and the ministry fourth.
- Give generously toward the mission and vision of Bridge.
- Give people the benefit of doubt and protect the unity of Bridge Fellowship.
- Demonstrate a Christ-like attitude through all interactions with congregation, staff, and volunteers.
- Evangelize the unchurched and invite people to church.

Compensation

This is a part time role, however the responsibilities listed above and the level of commitment required to perform all your duties with excellence will demand a lot of your time, talent, and personal resources. Therefore, effectively 1 May, the elders have decided to give you a stipend. This is just one of the many ways that we say: we love you, appreciate you, and we support you. The amount of your stipend is \$200.00 per month, this money is to be counted as additional income to be used as you see fit.

Commitment

This is a 6-month renewable commitment. Thank you for serving our church through this role. Know that you are helping BFC to realize our vision to reach 1% of South Raleigh with the Gospel.

Because we're committed to equipping our members for the work of ministry, Pastor Douglas will work with you to create a Leadership Development Plan specific to your goals. Once your plan is finalized, he will meet with you every 30 days to discuss your progress and provide guidance.
