


#### STATEMENT OF EDUCATIONAL EFFECTIVENESS

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Shepherds Theological Seminary exists to impact the world for Christ by equipping servant leaders for life and ministry by strategically shaping both intellect and character through biblical scholarship and personal mentoring.

Shepherds maintains an ongoing assessment of its educational effectiveness that is published on its web site and is available on request. The assessment is conducted annually with the graduating class and covers (1) overall student satisfaction, (2) student retention, degree completion, and career placement rates, (3) growth in student spiritual formation and knowledge, (4) most important factors affecting learning, (5) additional debt incurred, and (6) important sources of additional income while at Shepherds.

STUDENT RETENTION RATE—Of the degree-seeking students who were enrolled in the fall semester, how many either successfully completed their degree or were actively making progress towards their degree in the subsequent fall semester?



How does the May 2022 graduating class rate the factors influencing learning while at Shepherds?


FACTORS INFLUENCING LEARNING—What were the most important factors influencing learning while at Shepherds?

**Spiritual growth—**How strongly have these important areas been impacted?




Growth in Knowledge—How strongly have these important areas been impacted?





FOR THE 2022 GRADUATING CLASS, WHAT WERE THE MOST SIGNIFICANT FACTORS AFFECTING FINANCES?

#### STATEMENT OF EDUCATIONAL EFFECTIVENESS

TUITION AND FEES—Academic costs to complete degrees at Shepherds Seminary continue to be significantly lower than comparable ATS schools. Costs for MDiv degree programs are one-third less than the ATS average cost for programs requiring the same number of course hours. The DMin program costs are 42% less than reported ATS averages for Doctoral Degree Programs (DMin) for U.S. Schools with 75-150 FTE enrollment. A comparison of total educational costs to earn a degree for academic year 2021-22 is shown in the table below.

#### Notes for this table
